# Report of the Sixth Meeting of the Post-2020 Strategic Action Programme for the Conservation of Biodiversity and Sustainable Management of Natural Resources in the Mediterranean Region (Post-2020 SAPBIO) Advisory Committee

Videoconference, 07 March 2025

#### Introduction

- 1. The meeting aimed to inform about the Mid-term assessment of the collective implementation of the Post-2020 Strategic Action Programme for the Conservation of Biodiversity and Sustainable Management of Natural Resources in the Mediterranean Region (Post-2020 SAPBIO) with a focus on the start-up activities with a regional scope. It served also to share the introductory elements of the Post-2020 SAPBIO monitoring framework as requested by the Contracting parties at their 23<sup>rd</sup> Meeting (Decision IG 26/5, CoP23).
- 2. The meeting took place online, on Friday 07 March 2025, starting from 9:00 a.m., CET.

### **Participation**

- 3. The meeting was attended by the following members of the SAPBIO Advisory Committee: Regional Marine Pollution Emergency Response Centre for the Mediterranean Sea (REMPREC), Food and Agriculture Organization-General Fisheries Commission for the Mediterranean (FAO-GFCM), Agreement on the Conservation of Cetaceans of the Black Sea, Mediterranean Sea and Contiguous Atlantic Area (ACCOBAMS), Secretariat of the Union for the Mediterranean (UFM), International Union for Conservation of Nature Center for Mediterranean Cooperation (IUCN-Med), The European Topic Centre for Spatial Analysis and Synthesis (ETC-UMA), World Wildlife Fund Mediterranean Initiative (WWF MMI).
- 4. The Specially Protected Areas Regional Activity Centre (SPA/RAC) acted as the Secretariat of the meeting.
- 5. The list of participants is attached as Annex I to this report.

### Agenda item 1: Opening of the meeting

- 6. The meeting was opened by Mr. Mahmoud Elyes Hamza, SPA/RAC Director.
- 7. The agenda of the meeting is attached as Annex II to this report.

## Agenda item 2: Update on the Post-2020 SAPBIO implementation and the interconnection with other global and regional agenda

- 8. The Secretariat presented an update on the Post-2020 SAPBIO implementation.
- 9. The Post-2020 mid-term assessment' lead expert presented an update on the interconnection with other global and regional agenda, focusing on the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework (GBF) and its resource mobilization strategy.

## Agenda item 3: Mid-term assessment of the collective implementation of the Post-2020 SAPBIO with a focus on the start-up activities with a regional scope

10. The Secretariat presented the Mid-term assessment with a focus on start-up activities with a regional scope. It informed the meeting that:

- The analysis of Post-2020 SAPBIO' Goal 1, 'reduce the threats to biodiversity', presents a positive trend in action implementation but financial and systemic hurdles (policy and technical) need to be overcome for more effective progress.
- The analysis of Post-2020 SAPBIO' Goal 2, 'Ensuring Biodiversity for people's needs', shows a concerning trend, with significant implementation gaps, and that urgent attention is needed to address the identified challenges and get actions back on track.
- The analysis of Post-2020 SAPBIO' Goal 3, 'Enabling Transformative Change', presents a positive trend overall, however financial and systemic challenges (policy and technical) need to be addressed for smoother progress.
- 11. The Secretariat highlighted that despite the progress in certain areas, financial, policy and technical gaps challenges pose significant obstacles to achieving the Post-2020 SAPBIO objectives.
- 12. The mid-term assessment lead expert declared that these preliminary findings are aligning with the global framework, since finance is one of the main challenges facing the reality of implementing the global framework strategy.
- 13. The participants welcomed the preliminary findings of Mid-term assessment of the collective implementation of the Post-2020 SAPBIO with a focus on start-up activities with regional scope and requested a deepening analysis by considering the outcome of the means of verification section.
- 14. The participants requested to highlight the actions where the regional organizations didn't face any challenges, to have a realistic view of the difference between the relative actions.
- 15. The meeting invites the regional partners who didn't complete the online questionnaire with a focus on start-up activities with regional scope, to do it as soon as possible, but not later than the 14<sup>th</sup> of March 2025.
- 16. The Secretariat informed the participants that a deepening analysis of both national and regional scopes will be shared at the occasion of the upcoming national correspondents meeting, to be held in Athens, Greece, on 9 and 10 April 2025.
- 17. The meeting recommended that immediate action be taken at regional level to update and align fund mobilisation strategies considering the global resource mobilisation strategy.
- 18. The meeting suggested to encourage Mediterranean countries to develop their national biodiversity finance Plan and advocate for increased budgetary allocations at national level to ensure the successful implementation of the Post-2020 SAPBIO actions.

#### Agenda item 4: Post-2020 SAPBIO monitoring framework: Introductory elements

- 19. The Secretariat presented the introductory elements of the Post-2020 SAPBIO monitoring framework.
- 20. At the request of the Secretariat, the mid-term assessment lead expert updated the meeting on the progress of the GBF and its interconnection with the Pos-2020 SAPBIO.
- 21. The meeting commended the work undertaken by the Secretariat to prepare the introductory element of the Draft Monitoring Framework of the collective implementation of the Post-2020 SAPBIO.
- 22. Several participants highlighted the need to align the Post-2020 SAPBIO Monitoring Framework with the CBD Post-2020 GBF and define, hence, the right type and scope of indicators, baselines, including IMAP indicators, and provide capacity building for monitoring purposes.
- 23. The meeting agreed to extend the deadline to receive comments on the Introductory elements of the Draft Monitoring Framework of the collective implementation of the Post-2020 SAPBIO to the 14<sup>th</sup> of March 2025.

#### **Agenda item 5: Any other matters**

24. No other question related to the topics of the meeting were raised by participants or by the Secretariat.

#### Agenda item 6: Conclusion and recommendations

25. The meeting reviewed and endorsed the conclusions and recommendations prepared by the Secretariat, as they appear in Annex III to this report. It agreed that the report of the meeting will be prepared by the Secretariat and circulated by e-mail to the participants within two weeks.

### Agenda item 7: Closure of the meeting

- 26. The secretariat invited all the SAPBIO Advisory Committee members to attend the forthcoming SAPBIO National Correspondents meeting (9-10 April 2025, Athens, Greece) as observers.
- 27. Before closing the meeting, Mr. Mahmoud Elyes Hamza, Director of SPA/RAC, extended his appreciation to the members of the SAPBIO Advisory Committee for their attendance, and valuable contributions to the mid-term assessment of the Post-2020 SAPBIO.
- 28. The meeting was closed on Friday, 7 March 2025, at 11:34 a.m.

## Post-2020 SAPBIO Advisory Committee sixth meeting Videoconference, 7 March 2025

#### **Conclusions and recommendations**

- 1. The meeting welcomed the preliminary findings of Mid-term assessment of the collective implementation of the Post-2020 Strategic Action Programme for the Conservation of Biodiversity and Sustainable Management of Natural Resources in the Mediterranean Region (Post-2020 SAPBIO) with a focus on start-up activities with regional scope as provided by SPA/RAC Regional Partners. It stressed the need to take into consideration the information provided as a means of verification in the findings to have comprehensive results.
- 2. The meeting invites the partners who didn't complete the online questionnaire with a focus on start-up activities with regional scope, to proceed as soon as possible (14 March 2025).
- 3. Given that financial constraints, is identified in the preliminary findings on startup activities with regional scope, significantly impede progress across all Post-2020 SAPBIO goals and the CBD Global Biodiversity Framework, the meeting strongly recommended that immediate action be taken at regional level to update and align fund mobilisation strategies considering the global resource mobilisation strategy.
